1. EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES AND SKILLS

The general objective of the undergraduate study program *Finance and Banking* is the education of specialists with expertise in the field of finance, being oriented towards excellence, effectiveness and efficiency.

The objectives and the skills profile, developed in accordance with the needs identified on the labor market and the national qualifications framework, are summarized below and detailed in the syllabus.

The specific objectives are:

- students' understanding of the processes specific to the financial and banking field, as well as of the techniques regarding the financial operations;
- students' acquiring of the basic professional skills/knowledge in the financial and banking field, focusing on the acquisition of concepts, techniques, methods and tools as the basis for performance.

Professional skills:

- Appropriate use of concepts, theories, methods and financial instruments in the private and public entities/ organizations;
- ➤ Collecting, analyzing and interpreting data and information regarding economic and financial issues;
- Making economic and financial analysis at the level of the private and public entities/organizations;
- Execution of financial operations and transactions at the level of private and public entities;
- > Implementation of plans and budgets at the level of private and public entities/organizations;
- > Applying financial decisions at the level of private and public entities/organizations.

Transversal skills:

- Applying the principles, norms and values of professional ethics in their rigorous, efficient and responsible work strategy;
- ➤ Identifying roles and responsibilities in a pluri-specialized team and applying effective relationship and work techniques within the team;
- ➤ Identifying opportunities for lifelong learning and efficient use of learning resources and techniques for their own development.

2. ENSURING EDUCATION FLEXIBILITY. CONDITIONALITIES

The flexibility of the study programme is ensured by the elective, facultative and complementary disciplines.

Elective (optional) disciplines are offered in the semesters 3 to 6 and are grouped into optional packages that complement the student's specialization course. The choice of the professional path is made by the student, before the beginning of the academic year in which the semesters containing the packages of elective disciplines are included.

Facultative disciplines are proposed in the semesters 1 - 6 by the department or the faculty that manages the study programme, but they can also be chosen from packages offered by other faculties.

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The organization of the complementary disciplines: in the curriculum of each undergraduate study programme, the title of each elective complementary discipline is first recorded, then the name of the course is being entered into the registry record according to the student's option, from the list of complementary disciplines approved by the University Senate and available on the university website (www.uvt.ro). This includes the complementary disciplines proposed by the faculties in accordance with the *Regulation regarding the elaboration of the curriculum for the WUT study programmes*.

The procedure for carrying out the didactic activities for the elective and complementary disciplines and for recording the grades/qualifications in the Diploma Supplement is presented in the Regulation regarding the professional activity of the students and in the Regulation regarding the elaboration of the curriculum for the WUT study programmes.
