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**establishing a structured mobility program for students' exchange leading  
to a quadruple degree  
in Global Law and Transnational Studies (L-14) plus European Legal  
Studies (LM-90)  
and in Drept European și Internațional / European and International Law  
plus European Union Law**

**Having regard** to the European Strategy for Universities with the aim of facilitating the delivery of a Joint European Degree Label, considering the Blueprint for a European Degree released by the European Commission on 27th March 2024 aiming to work towards a European degree, as a result of a deeper and wider transnational cooperation between higher education institutions - a key component of the European Education Area;

**Having regard** to the Grant Agreement n. 101004082 which established the UNITA Alliance within the Erasmus+ Program for the period 01/11/2020-31/10/2023 and signed between the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA), the University of Torino, the Universidad de Saragoza, the Universidade da Beira Interior, the Universitatea de Vest din Timisoara, the Université Savoie Mont Blanc and the Université de Pau et des Pays de l'Adour;

**Having regard** to the Grant Agreement no. 101124853 whereby the extension of the project was financed for the period 01/11/2023-31/10/2027, also involving the Universitatea Transilvania din Brasov, the University of Brescia, the Instituto Politecnico da Guarda, the Universidad publica de Navarra, the Universitas Montium UNITA GEIE;

**Having regard to** the Italian Ministerial Decrees DM 509/99 and DM 270/04 allowing Italian Higher Education Institutions to develop joint study programs with other Italian and non-Italian institutions;

**Having regard to** the Ministerial Decree of 14 October 2021 No. 1154 "Self-assessment, Evaluation, Initial and Periodic Accreditation of Places and Courses of Study" as amended or added;

**Having regard to** the Decree No. 2711 of 22 November 2021 on the definition of the contents, operation and deadlines for the compilation of the *SUA-CdS* database for the initial accreditation of courses of study from the 2022-2023 academic year;

**Having regard to** the Romanian Act no. 199/2023 on higher education allowing Romanian Higher Education Institutions to develop common (double, multiple and joint) study programs with other Romanian and non-Romanian institutions;

**Considering** that the structured mobility program for students' exchange leading to the quadruple degree is accredited by the Italian Ministry of University and Research and by the Romanian Ministry of Education and that once approved, the program is not subject to expiry;

**Considering** that the acquired first and second cycle degrees give access to third cycle studies.

AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

## 1. Purposes

Considering that the University of Turin (UniTO) and the Universitatea de Vest din Timișoara are part of the UNITA Alliance of European Universities and that a priority objective of this alliance is to increase the mobility of students and teaching staff and to create flexible learning pathways, the Department of Law of UniTo and the Faculty of Law of Universitatea de Vest din Timișoara will collaborate in the realization of a structured mobility program for students' exchange leading to the quadruple degree in:

- *Global Law and Transnational Studies (L-14)*
- *European Legal Studies (LM-90)*
- *Drept European și Internațional / European and International Law*
- *European Union Law*

The parties will jointly define in a technical annex modules, seminars, exams and related credits of the joint program, as well as any other useful technical detail.

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### **3. Administrative management**

Relating to the Italian side, the Board for the relevant degree course shall manage all the administrative tasks (concerning the integrated study plan, the recognition of credits awarded and the conclusion of the student's career), in accordance with the provisions of the art. 22 of the Università degli Studi di Torino Statute approved by the Rector's Decree D.R. n. 1730 – March, 15, 2012.

Relating to the Romanian side, the Councils of the relevant departments and of the faculty, as well as the Dean and the vice-deans shall manage all the administrative tasks (concerning the integrated study plan, the recognition of credits awarded and the conclusion of the student's career), in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the Universitatea de Vest din Timișoara approved by the UVT Senate Decision of March, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.

### **4. Program and mobility management**

#### ***4.1 Participants' selection***

Each University will select the students who will attend the international mobility program. Mutual cooperation will be provided in the selection activity.

UniTO will start the participants' selection process by publishing a call within the semester preceding the beginning of the mobility.

UVT will start the participants' selection process by publishing a call within the semester preceding the beginning of the mobility.

As for the students of Università degli Studi di Torino:

Students willing to join the structured mobility program must have obtained before the application process a high school diploma, according to the art.6 DM 270/2004.

As for the students of Universitatea de Vest din Timișoara:

Students willing to join the structured mobility program must have obtained before the application process a high school (baccalaureate) diploma, according to the Act no. 199/2023 on higher education.

Each party is responsible for verifying that outgoing students possess the required diploma, as well as all the requirements mentioned in the call, in order to attend the study program at the host Institution. Language courses shall be available in the host country for foreign students joining the program.

#### ***4.2 Students' administrative management***

Students involved in the structured mobility program are enrolled in both institutions since the first academic year of the mobility program.

Both institutions involved guarantee to participants access to the courses and the issue of the final diplomas. The Home Institution will recognize courses and examinations attended by the student at the Host Institution in order to obtain the Bachelor's and the Master's Degrees.

Students will attend part of their degree courses at the Università degli Studi di Torino and part at the Universitatea de Vest din Timișoara according to the attached technical annex and the regulations in force in each Institution.

At the end of each part of the structured mobility program participants will submit a final dissertation/tesi/lucrare de licență/disertație, to be followed by an oral defense in one of the two Institutions as planned in the technical annex.

Students that successfully complete the study program, including the compulsory mobility period, will obtain four national degrees from the two Institutions. In addition, each student will receive the *diploma supplement* that details the participant's academic program and the academic achievements.

## **5. Professors/researchers and administrative staff mobility**

The Institutions regulate hosting and activities of professors/researchers and administrative staff participating in the mobility program, according to this agreement and the law and rules in force.

Staff involved in this agreement is subject to the contractual obligations of the home university, receives the due remuneration and benefits from the relevant rights, according to the home country law.

Professors and researchers can hold modules, courses, seminars, conferences, as well as take part in research activities, within the limits of the Regulations in force at the home University.

## **6. Financial management of the structured mobility program, fees and ancillary contribution**

The Institutions commit to find, whether necessary, the financial resources in order to achieve the abovementioned purposes.

Both Parties agree that all financial obligations should be negotiated in advance and will depend on funding availability.

Financial burden related to the activities covered by this cooperation agreement will be charged on the single Department directly involved in the initiative, unless otherwise agreed.

Mobile students are exempt from paying enrolment fees at the Host Institution and must pay fees exclusively at the Home Institution.

Nevertheless, ancillary contribution, whether it is provided by internal regulations, is due for the total extent of the degree courses at the host institution.

## **7. Student Services**

Students taking part in the mobility program are subject to the rules and norms in force at the hosting institution.

All students enrolled in the mobility program will receive the same services offered to students enrolled in ordinary study programs at both Institutions involved. The parties will provide students with any useful information in order to assisting their stay during the mobility period. Costs related to expatriation procedures, accommodation and staying will be at the expense of students, unless otherwise agreed.

## **8. Insurance coverage**

Each person involved in the activities set out in this agreement must be covered by an insurance for civil liability, usually paid by the home Institution.

Within the limits of the policy general and specific conditions, the insurance provides protection for accidents connected to institutional activities and duties previously authorized, in accordance with internal existing regulations, and carried out inside the university premises or third parties' premises.

This agreement does not provide coverage for medical and health costs. Each person involved must assume the related financial burdens.

## **9. Quality assurance of the degree course**

Institutions commit to guarantee the quality of the mobility program, according to their national standards.

As for UniTO, the degree courses are subject to quality assurance national regulations, according to the standards of the National Agency for the Evaluation of the University and Research Systems (ANVUR) for self-evaluation, evaluation and accreditation.

As for UVT, the degree courses are subject to quality assurance national regulations, according to the standards of the Romanian Agency for the Quality Assurance in Higher Education (ARACIS) for self-evaluation, evaluation and accreditation.

## **10. Dispute resolutions**

Any conflict that may arise between the signing Institutions, regarding interpretation, non-validity, execution, modification, termination of this agreement, will be settled amicably and by negotiation.

If the parties cannot achieve an agreed solution, the dispute should be submitted to the unappealable decision of an Arbitration Committee. This will be appointed ad hoc and it will be composed by at least three members. Each Party will appoint one of the members; these, in turn, will appoint by mutual agreement a third member acting as President.

## **11. Intellectual property**

Technical and scientific results obtained within this agreement and the related rights will be owned by the Party generating them. Should the Parties reach such results jointly, the royalties will be co-owned. Each Party shall grant a free non-exclusive license to the other Party for the non-commercial use of the joint results.

A Party intending to publish any results generated in the framework of this agreement shall duly mention the name and participation of the other Party. Publication activities shall be compatible with the protection of intellectual property rights, confidentiality obligations and the legitimate interests of the owner(s) of the results.

At least 30 days prior notice of any publication activity shall be given to the other Party concerned, including sufficient information concerning the planned publication activity. The notification shall be given, via email, to the scientific Responsible of the Agreement.

Within 15 days of the notification the other Party may object to the envisaged publication activity if it considers that it can damage its legitimate interests.

In such cases, the publication activity may not take place unless appropriate steps are taken to safeguard these legitimate interests.

## **12. Confidentiality**

Unless otherwise expressly authorized, and according to the current agreement obligations, each partner institution agrees to keep strictly confidential all information provided and marked as confidential.

Applicable law on privacy and personal data: Italian Legislative Decree (D. Lgs. n. 101/2018 in observance of the EU Regulation 679/2016) and the Romanian Act no. 190/2018 in observance of the EU Regulation 679/2016 about privacy and personal data.

## **13. Duration, modification and renewal**

This agreement is valid starting from the date of last signature by the Legal representatives of the contracting Institutions and upon approval of competent Academic Bodies. This agreement covers five academic years: 2024-2025, 2025-2026, 2026-2027, 2027-2028, 2028-2029.

Any amendment to this agreement must be approved in writing by both parties.

This agreement can be renewed for an equal period, by mutual written approval of the competent academic bodies, at least three months before the expiring date.

Any modification or updating of the technical annex could be also agreed after the signature of this agreement, according to the regulations in force at the moment of the mobility.

## **14. Drafting and signature**

This agreement, written in English, Italian and Romanian, all texts being equally authentic, is signed in 2 copies for each language. In case of divergence in the meaning of the texts, the English version shall prevail. Each Institution will keep at least one copy in each language.

## TECHNICAL ANNEX

### **Program description:**

International degree course to be implemented through a structured incoming-outgoing program in the framework of the Italian courses leading to the award of the Bachelor in Global Law and Transnational Studies (L-14) and Master in European Legal Studies (LM-90) and the Romanian courses leading to the award of Bachelor in Drept European și Internațional / European and International Law and Master in European Union Law.

Through a structured 5-years incoming-outgoing mobility program, the selected students will be given the possibility to award 2 national bachelor's degrees and 2 Master's degrees. Students enrolled in the program will spend 2 out of 5 years of study abroad. The key purpose of the program is to provide an education path that makes students competitive both in the national (Italian and Romanian) and in the international context. Specific focus will be dedicated to European and transnational issues.

### **Start date:**

### **Official length of program:**

5 academic years

### **Program Structure:**

Each year, at the beginning of the second semester, both Institutions publish a call for the selection of students interested in taking part in the mobility program. During their first academic year, students enrolled in the Bachelor in Global law and Transnational Studies at UniTO and students enrolled in Bachelor in Drept European și Internațional / European and International Law at UVT can submit an application at their Home university.

Each University select the students to be admitted to the international mobility program. Mutual cooperation is provided in the selection activity, with specific regard to linguistic skills required to successfully take part in the program. Language courses are available in the host university for foreign students joining the program to improve their linguistic skills.

Each party is responsible for verifying that outgoing students possess the required diploma, as well as all the requirements mentioned in the call, in order to attend the study program at the host Institution.



Students admitted to the structured mobility program are enrolled in both institutions since the first academic year of the mobility program.

Students enrolled in the program spend 2 out of 5 years of study at the host university.

In particular:

as for students from Turin, at the end of their third year, they award the Bachelor's degree in Global Law and Transnational Studies. Then, they enrol in the UniTO Master degree program in European Legal Studies but they spend their first year of academic path in Timisoara, attending the fourth year of the Bachelor degree program in Drept European și Internațional / European and International Law. At the end of the fourth year, they award the Bachelor's degree issued by UVT. The fifth year, they return to Turin and attend the second year of the Master degree program in European Legal Studies, being at the same time enrolled at the UVT Master degree program in European Union Law. At the end of the last year, they award both UniTO and UVT Master's degrees.

as for students from Timisoara, they spend their second academic year in Turin, attending the UniTO Global Law and Transnational Studies Bachelor's degree courses. At the third year, they return to Timisoara. At the end of the fourth year, they award both the UVT and UniTO Bachelor's degrees and enrol in the UVT Master program in European Union Law. Then they leave and spend their second year of mobility in Turin, being at the mean time enrolled at the UVT master and at the second year of the UniTO Master in European Legal Studies. At the end of the fifth year, they award both UniTO and UVT Master's degrees.

Full time students

### **Students' mobility flows**

A limited number of students can participate in the program. In particular, each year 10 students from UniTO and 10 students from UVT may be selected to participate in structured mobility program.

### **Degree Structure:**

Università degli Studi di Torino, in order to award the quadruple-degree:

- a) regarding students enrolled at UniTO, is required to specify the correspondence between exams/credits obtained from partner University and exams/credits from the home degree course program in the mobility year/period, as indicated in the annexed schemes (Annex nn. A, B, C);
- b) regarding students enrolled at the partner Institution, is required to detail activities and correspondence of the exams/credits obtained in the mobility/period and during the whole degree course.

Universitatea de Vest din Timișoara, in order to award the quadruple-degree:

- a) regarding students enrolled at UVT is required to specify the correspondence between exams/credits obtained from partner University and exams/credits from the home degree course program in the mobility year/period;
- b) regarding students enrolled at the partner Institution, is required to detail activities and correspondence of the exams/credits obtained in the mobility/period and during the whole degree course.

Both Institutions recognize courses, examinations and activities attended by the students at the Host Institution in order to award the Bachelor's and the Master's Degrees

As for the plan of studies of the four degrees to be awarded, parties agree on the annexed schemes (Annex nn. A, B, C)

The activities detailed by both Università degli Studi di Torino and Universitatea de Vest din Timișoara may vary according to the Academic offer of the relevant Academic Year.

### **Final dissertation or Tesi/Lucrare de licență / Disertație**

In order to award the title, all the degree programs require to submit a final dissertation/tesi/lucrare de licență/disertație. Given the structured nature of the mobility program, students are required to write and submit a final work for the bachelor's degree programs and another one for the master's degree programs. Based on the nature of the mobility program, final works have to be written in English.

In particular:

as for the students from Turin, they have to prepare their bachelor program final thesis at the end of the third year and submit it to the UniTO academic institutions. UniTO academic regulation do not ask for public discussion/defence of the final works, it being established only a graduation ceremony. These final works might be recognized as the final thesis of the

Romanian bachelor program. Therefore, at the end of the fourth year, students have to discuss their work before a Romanian jury.

as for students from Timisoara, they have to submit and discuss their final work at the end of the fourth year before a UVT jury. Such a work is fully recognised by UniTO in order to award the bachelor's degree.

At the end of the fifth year, both students from Turin and students from Timisoara have to submit and discuss a master's degree final thesis before a UniTO jury. Such a work is fully recognised by UVT in order to award the master's degree.

Both for bachelor's and master's degrees, students may choose to be supervised by an UniTO as well as an UVT professor. The supervisor will take part in the jury appointed to award the title.

### **Awarded Titles:**

Students that successfully complete the study program, including the compulsory mobility period, will obtain four national degrees from the two Institutions.

Year 3-4:

Bachelor's degree in Global law and Transnational Studies (L-14) [Università di Torino]

Bachelor's degree in Drept European și Internațional / European and International Law [Universitatea de Vest din Timișoara]

Year 5:

Master's degree in European Legal Studies (LM-90) [Università di Torino]

Master's degree in European Union Law [Universitatea de Vest din Timișoara]

In addition, each student will receive the *diploma supplement* that details the participant's academic program and the academic achievements.

### **Program Regulations.**

#### **Entry Requirements**

A. As for students from Università degli Studi di Torino: It is required to have obtained before the application process a high school diploma, according to the art. 6 DM 270/2004 and to have successfully taken the entry test to the bachelor's degree program in Global Law and Transnational Studies activate at UniTO.

B. As for students from Universitatea de Vest din Timișoara: It is required to have obtained before the application process a high school (baccalaureate) diploma, according to the Act no. 199/2023 on higher education and to have passed the admission exam for the bachelor's degree in Drept European și Internațional / European and International Law and for the master's degree in European Union Law.

To be admitted in the program students both from UniTO and UVT must give evidence of good linguistic skills (mastery of both Romanian and English languages) and an average grade of at least 26/30 according to the Italian grade system or 8/10 according to the Romanian grade system.

#### **Program requirements:**

According to the terms of the Didactic Regulation of the Degree Course, as stated by the University Didactic Rules:

in order to be awarded the degree in Global law and Transnational Studies (L-14), students must acquire at least 180 ECTS;

in order to be awarded the degree in Drept European și Internațional / European and International Law), students must acquire at least 240 ECTS;

in order to be awarded the degree in European Legal Studies (LM-90), students must acquire at least 120 ECTS;

in order to be awarded the degree in degree in European Union Law), students must acquire at least 60 ECTS.

However, given the structured nature of the mobility program, in order to be awarded all the four degrees, students must attend all the courses and activities provided for in the study plan agreed upon by both Institutions.

In order to not be removed from the structured mobility program, students must have an average grade of at least 26/30 according to the Italian grade system or 8/10 according to the Romanian grade system.

In case students do not comply with provisions provided for in the present agreement, exams and activities held during the mobility periods are recognized by the home university according to the terms of the Didactic Regulation of the Degree Course, as stated by the University Didactic Rules.

## **Didactic Purposes**

### **1) Access to further study programs**

Upon completion of the International Mobility Program carried out through an incoming-outgoing mobility program in the framework of the Italian courses leading to the award of

- Bachelor' s Degree in Global Law and Transnational Studies (L-14)
- Master' s Degree in European Legal Studies (LM-90)

and the Romanian courses leading to the award of

- Drept European și Internațional / European and International Law
- European Union Law

graduates will have the knowledge and skills needed to the third level of Higher Education Programs (PhD) as well as other professionalising post-graduate education programs in the field of legal studies.

### **2) Professional status**

This International Mobility Program to be carried out through an incoming-outgoing mobility program in the framework of the Italian courses leading to the award of

- Bachelor' s Degree in Global Law and Transnational Studies (L-14)
- Master' s Degree in European Legal Studies (LM-90)

and the Romanian courses leading to the award of

- *Drept European și Internațional / European and International Law*
- *European Union Law*

aims at building skills needed to perform technical or professional roles defined in various fields both at national (Romanian and Italian), European and international level. The graduates will also be ready to perform legal advisory duties for companies, banks, and service companies, as well as to operate within the legal divisions of large multinational organizations, NGOs, public administrations and, as an analyst, in research institutes and think tanks.

The degree courses entitle to the following professions:

Attorneys at law, magistrates, notaries public or other legal professions in Romania, subject to having passed the national admission exam to the respective legal profession

Legal experts in law firms

Legal experts in companies at national and international level

Legal experts in public bodies at national and international level

Specialists in the management of Public Administration

Specialists in the control of Public Administration
