Description of the PhD project

The project intends to bring into focus the work of Raúl Damonte Botana, better known with his penname Copi. A polymorphous artist, Copi deconstructs in his drama the autocratic heterosexual language, while reconstructing and bringing together antagonizing effects, complex sensitivities, which can be traditional or topical, in order to understand his own existential division. The main purpose of this doctoral project would be to approach Copi's theatre starting from a voyage within the world of the theatre itself, investigating words, gestures and postures which bear witness of the artist's various selves, as well as the way they interact with others. The research aims to capitalize on the means, the causes and the effects of the dramatization of interiority for whose accomplishment Copi engages an entire arsenal of dramatic techniques. The study of the deconstruction and reconstruction of conflicting relations, of the creation and decreation of his fictions and chimeras can contribute to grasping the logic of identity stigmatization, as it was perceived by Copi, and to compensating the identity effacement by means of signs and metasigns in the theatre.

The topic is open and generous, with an interdisciplinary and transversal feature that emphasizes intercultural, multicultural and global approaches:
